### **BORDER CONTROL MEASURES FOR INFLUENZA A (H1N1)**

- A) TEMPERATURE SCREENING**

#### Temperature Screening

1 With effect from 2200 hours on 3 May 09, in addition to the sea checkpoints, temperature screening will also be conducted for all ships' crew and passengers disembarking at terminals, private wharves, fishery ports and marinas.

#### Home Quarantine Order

2 All ships' crew and passengers entering the port of Singapore with a travel history to Mexico over the past seven (7) days will be issued a home quarantine order which will require them to be quarantined for seven days when they enter Singapore. Hence, shipmasters, shipowners and agents are to advise ships' crew and passengers to remain onboard, if they have a travel history to Mexico over the past seven (7) days. This is to avoid a home quarantine order when they come ashore.

Additional Information to Immigration and Checkpoints Authority (ICA)

3 Shipmasters, shipowners and agents are also required to inform the Immigration and Checkpoints Authority on the details of their crew and passengers who have a travel history to Mexico over the past seven (7) days, when requesting for immigration clearances.

Medical Arrangements

4 For routine medical checks and other illness, agents are advised to make the necessary arrangements and accompany ships' crew and passengers.
